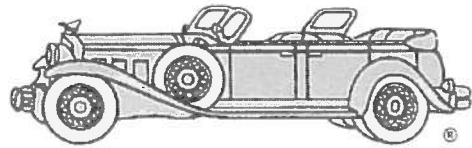


Over the river and through the woods to Sweigard's house we go...

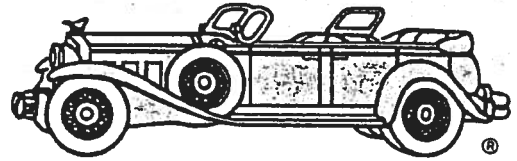
Old Business: Gary asked Joe Platten to send a letter to Rita Addams. Members may be able to be on the board even if they winter in another area and miss meetings.

Director: Gary Rosenthal. Gary advised of several letters from National he received. He would explain them later on.

Asst. Director: Dave Heinrichs. No report.

Secretary- Joe Platten. The minutes of the June meeting were accepted as written.

Treasurer- Al Truelson. Al advised that our checking account balance at this time is \$12,875.11 and our CD stands at \$5,702.20. The financial report for Stan Hywet is not yet complete.

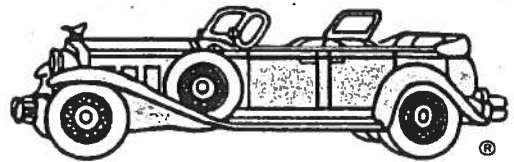
