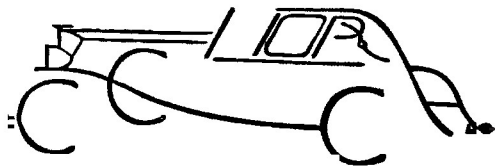

Spring Adventure Tour on Saturday, May 23rd

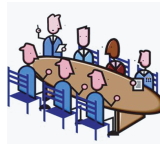

Between 1897 and 1936, Cleveland boasted over 80 automobile manufacturers and northern Ohio over 115. The more well-known marques include Winton, Stearns, Stearns-Knight, Owen Magnetic, White, Peerless, Royal Tourist, Cleveland, Star, Chandler, Jordan, Templar, early Packard, Studebaker-Garford, Baker, Rauch and Lang among others. Activities at the gathering will include driving tours through historical Cleveland communities and talks on Cleveland-built cars. The Crawford Auto Museum will be open for tours, while the Peerless Automobile Club will be holding its national meet within the show. Northern Lights Trophy - Members choice of an article in the Northern Lights written by a regional member.

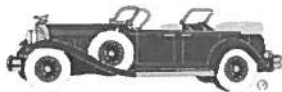
Paige Palmer Award - For the 3 year or newer member contributing the most to the betterment of the Club.

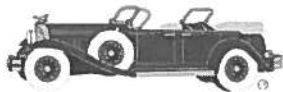

Meeting called to order by Dave at 7:30

Director: Dave Heinrichs - Dave opened by sharing news of passing of our friend Tom Sutphen. Dave made a motion that we purchase a brick at the museum in honor of him. Second by Margus, carried. Joan said she would take care of the arrangement. Dave let everyone know the annual meeting was coming up later that week and that the Heinrichs and Harwoods would be attending and volunteering as judges.
