Won't you join us for a great weekend in Roscoe Village, outside the town of Coshocton, Ohio?

Roscoe Village served as an important canal port during the Ohio and Lake Erie Canal's boom years of the 1840's and '50's. The canal was built to join Lake Erie to the Ohio River, thus making commerce of the day more easily obtained. The chug of locomotives and the flood of 1913 ended the canal's commercial importance, and the town fell into disrepair.

A restoration project, begun in the 1900's, now boasts five canal era exhibit buildings, a large museum, as well as horse-drawn restored canal boat rides, quaint shops in Greek Revival buildings, and lovely gardens. Interpreters, in 1830's dress, demonstrate weaving, pottery making, and blacksmithing. The Johnson-Humrick House Museum has an outstanding collection of Indian, Oriental, and Indian decorative arts.
